## 2. PREVIOUS MINUTES/BUSINESS ARISING & REPORT

### 2.1 -Business arising

- 2.1.1 -Life Membership – Draft entry required for new club rule regarding Life Membership. Wording of the Rule should include that;
- 2.1.1.1 The award should not be seen as a regular or annual award such as the ‘Clubman of the Year’
  - 2.1.1.2 The award should reflect something extraordinary or special, endorsed by the committee current at the time
  - 2.1.1.3 There may never be another Life Membership awarded
  - 2.1.1.4 Nominees should have been club members for a minimum ten years
  - 2.1.1.5 Once endorsed by the committee, nominations will be presented to the membership at the next AGM

## 3. GENERAL BUSINESS

- 3.1. A request has been received from the VJMC asking for help. The VJMC secretary (Dave Williams) is currently unwell and has asked if the committee objects to a CMRCWA member acting as temporary Registrar for the VJMC. The volunteer could be the current registrar of the CMRCWA. The committee could see no conflict with such an arrangement.  
Proposed: Stuart McCormack, Seconded: Wayne Fletcher, Motion Carried
- 3.2. Discussion around a better club online presence, particularly for Impromptu Ride registrations and also for disseminating information. Wayne Fletcher has found a service which will cost around \$20-30 per month and proposed that we commit to a trial period of twelve months. Fletch will co-ordinate. Seconded Stuart McCormack, Motion Carried.
